Michael Birch as the wicked Mr Frankland is the epitome of the traditional Victorian villain with dark moustache, glinting eyes and shifty expression.

It is a musical melodrama and Sharon Clark's rich voice and charismatic presence as the Ward adds an extra dimension to the comic capers. However, The Cosy Ladies' tuneful continuity chorus is unnecessary and tends to slow down what is an otherwise fast moving entertainment with a cast of strong characters.

The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Bumble

SUBTITLED, "or who framed Doctor Gray?", this amusing jape by the amanuastically named Kjartan Poskitt conflates Conan Doyle with Robert Louis Stevenson and Oscar Wilde, to produce ingeniously, from the London Actors Theatre Company, Sherlock Holmes and Watson (Igor Thompson and Eva Fontaine) pursuing the photographer Dr Jekyll (Andrew Calloway) who literally frames man about town Dorian Gray (Erika Poole), and whose wicked alter ego is caught on a ruined photograph and comes to life.

Chris Fisher directs all this agreeable nonsense with panache and a good time is had by all, particularly by Calloway, who sings wickedly and plausibly with gyrating hips, but the idea is so charming and potentially

interesting that one can imagine a more thorough and imaginative approach producing a storyline able to genuinely hold the attention on different levels of both adults and children.

"I don't believe in that one", my small neighbour said darkly when Erika Poole appeared as the housekeeper praised by her good employer but shamelessly abused by his doppelganger, Robin Dalgleish pounds away at the piano and Nick Shuback is the musical director, to good effect, though several song titles, notably Mad, Bad and Dangerous To Know, promise more than they deliver.

Set design by Edna Richardson and costume design by Arabela White is glorifyingly over the top: late Victorian England needs lots of fog swirling, and glorifying several small children present sobbed with fear, a sure sign of success.





It seems at first glance a bold experiment to send a *Claude Duval* company "on the road" without sending Mr Roberts with it; but, in practice, the musical piece, even without the adored Arthur, forms an entertainment which proves enjoyable to many, if we may judge from the laughter and applause evoked by the performances given by Mr Hardt H. Nelson's capital company at the Elephant and Castle Theatre this week. This satisfactory result is greatly owing to the exertions of Mr H. C. Barry. Mr Barry has a difficult task to perform in following Mr Roberts. Of course, all the bits of business which we may reasonably suppose to have been invented by that gentleman are reproduced by Mr Barry; but he does not attempt any direct imitation of his predecessor in the part. His natural style is replete with restlessness energy, and he throws himself into his work with commendable earnestness and ability. In his duet with Miss Winifred Hare as Marjorie Samundham, he develops all the droll patter of his share with bold and impulsive vivacity, and throughout Mr Barry's performance is duly dashing, daring, and desperate. Miss Winifred Hare looks extremely pretty as Marjorie, and supports Mr Barry with great delicacy and tact. Mr Michael Dwyer plays Sir Philip Samundham in genuine comedy style, and makes a fine old English gentleman, his make-up being

excellent. Mr W. T. Thompson strikes a vein of keen, eccentric absurdity as *Sherlock Holmes Speller*, and gives a particularly clever and original reading of the rôle of the burlesque detective. His dancing is very smart, and his alert and intense comicality is fully appreciated. Mr Tom Wallace is duly droll as Pincher, and Miss Kate Kearney plays Lady Joan Samundham in a sharp, light, and effective manner. Miss Belena Little is admirable in every way as Lady Doreas Chetwynd. Her singing is most praiseworthy, and her gracious presence and agreeable acting make her performance a very pleasant one. The chorus is large and well-trained, the full company amounting to no less than fifty persons. A good deal of the properties are, we imagine, carried by the company, and the appointments and accessories are all excellent. Miss Claire Vanis does a smart solo dance in each act, and Miss Nellie Arline contributes a clever banjo performance to the second division of the musical piece. Mr H. Adair Nelson, the active and energetic business manager for Mr Nelson, performs his duties with his wonted courtesy.

"Sherlock Holmes," at Bijou.

"Sherlock Holmes," the most fascinating character in detective fiction, will walk the stage of the Grays Inn Road Bijou this week, when the play of that name will be presented by Miss Grays Inn Road and her company.

When William Gillette dramatized this celebrated character, he based the play on the experience of the unfortunate Miss Faulkner, one of the most thrilling and interesting stories by Conan Doyle.

Miss Faulkner's sister had died of a broken heart, after having been jilted by a Hungarian nobleman, and, angry and resentful of her sister's treat-
ment, Miss Faulkner vowed to have revenge. She sets out to seek it through some letters of the nobleman to her dead sister, which are in Miss Faulkner's possession.

When this nobleman's marriage to another woman is announced, she decides to publish the letters. He tries to get them from her and failing, calls in Sherlock Holmes and commissions him to get the letters.

Another man is trying to get them—James Lawrence, who, with his wife, is one of the most noted blackmailers in Europe. Learning that the girl has the letters in her possession, and thinking that he can extort a large sum of money from the writer, if they can get them from the girl, they pretend to sympathize with her. They take her to London and keep her a prisoner in their home, where Lawrence's wife tries to get the letters from her. But by this time the girl has learned their real character and refuses to give them the letters, hiding them in a secret place, which even their cunning cannot discover.



Sherlock Holmes is called in, and quickly discovers the hiding place, but he believes that he can get the letters for his clients by being a friend to the girl and appealing to her better nature, than by forcing them from her. No sooner has it become known to the criminals of London that Holmes has taken the case, than it is reported to Professor Moriarty, the Napoleon of all criminals and the absolute master of every branch of criminology in London.

This sinister, bony, desperate ear of the underworld has been crossed so many times by Holmes that he wants nothing more than Sherlock Holmes's death. This seems to be the opportunity that he has been waiting for, and he plans first to kill Holmes, and then share the profits to be made on the letters held by the girl. From that time on, the play deals with the battle of wits between the greatest of criminals and the greatest foe of crime and the development of the love between Sherlock Holmes and Alice Faulkner.

William Thompson will play the title role and Miss Scott will be seen as Alice Faulkner. The Monday night's performance will be given for the benefit of the Samuels Grotto, Mystic Order of Veiled Prophets, members of which will be present in full regalia. "Sherlock Holmes" was selected as the play to be presented, as it is the one that will command the interest of all.



Thorpe Mayne, in which that gentleman, as **Sherlock Holmes** and Mr Clement Hamelin, as the conquering **Raffles**, both did well. But the little play will go still better after further performance. It will, we understand, precede each of the week's remaining performances.





Visitors to this comfortable little hall this week will find many good things much to their taste. Heading the bill is Tom Leamore, in as fine form as ever. His old sailor's song is very funny, and that in which he appears as a Gordon Highlander is one of his best. He keeps the audience in thorough good humour throughout, and his step dancing creates the heartiest laughter. Bobb and Sibb, a couple of comic performers upon the double jiggs, make a hearty hit and are as clever as any in their line of business. Mr. Moretti and Alice have something special to offer in the way of a fixed comic act. Miss Daisy Janey sings a comic song about a young lady who made a lot of money out of a Coronation window. Captain Blingsby gives a clever vaudeville act; and La Tottie plays a selection from "F. Fawcett" upon the mandolin with fine expression, and also gives several popular airs upon the same instrument, which are much appreciated. Mr. W. T. Churchill's comedy is most emphatic, and there is laughter all the time he is on the stage. Mr. Banister is all the more selling because it is never forced, and the songs he sings are genuinely funny. Messrs. George Marriott and Co. present their exciting sketch, "The Gripard's Grip," in which Miss Edith Flaherty is to be commended for some clever scenes and dainty acting, and Mr. Otto Minister for his witty and restrained portrayal of the hero.
